You can delete or add letters to work, copy and paste, spell check and even apply outline, guideline or arrowed variants of the font. It is truly incredible!

### How to use Aussie School Fonts Plus

To use Aussie School Fonts Plus you just install the set of fonts relevant to your state on your Apple or Windows computer, open your favourite word processor, including Microsoft Word and Apple Pages, select the font variant you want to use and start typing.

The Print and PreCursive fonts are beautifully formed giving reliable, accurate guidance, example and practice for all the letters.

With the Cursive and Speed Loop fonts the magic happens live on screen with each keystroke! Our SmartLink<sup>™</sup> Logic invisibly takes care of the complex matters of selecting the forms of the letters and joins live and on the fly using a library of up to 4,000 logical rules and the hundreds of glyphs (characters)! The result is perfect handwriting that accords with the latest style guides issued by the Department of Education in your State!

### **Apple and Windows Installation Instructions**

Aussie School Fonts Plus is *not* a website or a web delivered application. It is software designed to be installed on your Apple or Windows computer.

# Aussie School Fonts Plus will not work on iPad or Android tablet.

In order to use Aussie School Fonts Plus, you must first install it onto your computer. It is not a website nor an installable application. It is a set of fonts that are installed into your computer's font folders.

### Windows installation

- 1. Download the Aussie School Fonts Plus installer from the link provided in the email you received after purchase.
  - A. Search for the Aussie School Fonts Plus .exe file in your downloads folder, unless you have set the download to go elsewhere.
  - B. Aussie School Fonts Plus may have been provided to your on a disk or by other means. If so locate the file there and proceed as follows.
- 2. Right click on the .exe file and select "Extract here" from the drop down menu. If this is not there and you can see 7zip, hover over that and then select "Extract here" from the extended menu.
- 3. (If you do not have extraction software installed, you can easily download and install one from the web, such as winRAR)
- 4. Search for a file called installer launcher from the same folder (e.g. downloads).
- 5. Double click on installerlauncher to start the Aussie School Fonts Plus installation wizard.
- 6. Follow the prompts to install the fonts onto your device.
- 7. After Aussie School Fonts Plus has been installed, you can access the fonts from the font menu inside the word processor of your choice.
- 8. After installation the Installation and User Guide, Wall Charts and the Slope Cards can be accessed from the EdAlive folder located in the Windows Start menu.

### MacOS

1. Download the Aussie School Fonts Plus installer from the link provided in the email you received after purchase. It should look like this once downloaded:



#### If Aussie School Fonts Plus has been provided to you on a disk or by other means. If so locate the file and proceed as follows.

2. Activate the dmg. file by double clicking on it to get the actual program that you need to run. It should look like this:



3. After running the program it should come up with this list of options. From here choose the fonts you wish to install.



4. After selecting your font follow the prompts to install them. After you have done so this page should appear:



5. Make sure to use the installation and user guide which you can find under the manual tab. The Instructions on the ligatures for Apple computes are as follows:

### **System Requirements**

### Windows: Windows 10 or later

#### Software supported:

- Microsoft Word 2010 and later (must enable "Ligatures" accessible from the "Font" menu or see the Word manual for details), Adobe CS2 Products and later, OpenOffice Writer 3.2 and later
- Any software that supports OpenType Ligatures or Smartfont typography

### Apple: MacOS 10.4.9 or later

#### Software supported:

- Microsoft Word (must enable "Ligatures" accessible from the "Format" menu or see the Word manual for details), Pages, Keynote, TextEdit and Adobe products
- Any software that supports OpenType Ligatures or Smartfont typography

## **Network Deployment / Installation**

Aussie School Fonts Plus supports network deployment of the fonts for both Windows and Apple. This can be used to ease the workload of school network administrators wishing to deploy Aussie School Fonts Plus to multiple computers on their network. Please note that you must not install Aussie School Fonts Plus onto more computers than your licence allows.

### Windows network installation

To install to multiple networked Windows computers, use the MSI (Microsoft Installer package) along with Group Policy.

### MacOS network installation

To install to multiple networked Apple computers, use the PKG (Apple installer package) with Apple Remote Desktop.

### Using Aussie School Fonts Plus with Microsoft Word

The Smart Link<sup>™</sup> Logic used by the Aussie School Fonts Plus Cursive and Speed Loop fonts harnesses the power of ligatures. With Microsoft Word documents ligatures are disabled by default. It is therefore necessary to enable them when using the Cursive and Speed Loop fonts.

### Enabling Ligatures: Microsoft Word for Windows Microsoft Word

- 1. Launch your copy of Word.
- 2. Open the Font dialogue box by pressing 'Ctrl+D'.
- 3. Click on the Advanced tab.
- 4. Set the menu next to Ligatures to "All".
- 5. Under OpenType Features (above the preview at the bottom), check the box "Use contextual alternatives".
- 6. Click "Set As Default", check the box "All documents based on the Normal.dotm template?" then click OK.
- 7. Select the required Aussie School Fonts Plus font from your Font menu and start typing.

# Enabling Ligatures: Microsoft Word for Apple

#### Microsoft Word

- 1. Launch your copy of Word.
- 2. Open the Font dialogue box by pressing 'Cmd+D'.
- 3. Click on the Advanced tab.
- 4. Under OpenType Features (above the preview at the bottom), check the box "Use contextual alternatives".
- 5. Set the menu next to Ligatures to "All", click Default..., then click OK.
- 6. Select the required Aussie School Fonts Plus font from your Font menu and start typing.

# Troubleshooting

### Problems with older versions of Microsoft Word

Aussie School Fonts Plus is divided into font families which are usually accessed via the font menu in the software being used. Some older versions of Microsoft Word and/or other applications, have a basic font menu that only allows the selection of the font family and the application of Bold and Italic or a combination of the two.

Follow the steps below to access Aussie School Fonts Plus in an application using basic font menus as described above:

- 1. Select the font you wish to use. By default the Regular version of the font will be selected.
- 2. To make the font Bold click on the "Bold" option
- 3. To make the font Dashed click on the "Italic" option
- 4. To make the font Outlined click on both the "Bold" and "Italic" options

Please note that some fonts do not contain bold or outline versions. Please check the relevant section of this manual for a full list of fonts available for your state or territory.

### My letters are all bunched up when I type

Ensure that you have set up Ligatures as per the instructions for installing Aussie School Fonts on your Apple or Windows computer.

#### I can't access the dashed/outlined fonts

- 1. To make the font Bold click on the "Bold" option
- 2. To make the font Dashed click on the "Italic" option
- 3. To make the font Outlined click on both the "Bold" and "Italic" options

### Mac OS Gatekeeper

With Apple's Operating systems since Catalina (10.15) Apple introduced software called Gatekeeper which affects the use of any software not purchased from the Apple App Store. To get around this change follow these steps:

- 1. Go to Finder to click on the Package file for the EdAlive Software you wish to install.
- 2. Hold Control and click on the Package file.
- 3. A pop-up will appear asking if you would like to open the App. Click Open to start the installation process and make the EdAlive software an exclusion to the rules set up by Gatekeeper

# **The Utility Font**

Aussie School Fonts Plus contains a Utility font for creating worksheets.

The Utility font for your state will be under the state name in the font list, called "(State) EdAlive Utility". Please note: In some circumstance the name of the Utility font may appear in the font list as a series of slashes and horizontal lines.

The Utility font uses keys on a standard keyboard and allows you to create worksheets with various styles of guidelines, slope lines, and guideline naming aids.

To access the Utility Font characters select the your state's Utility font from the font menu of the software you are using and then press the appropriate key as indicated in the tables below. Please note that the keys as denoted are case sensitive.

### Handwriting and the National Curriculum

The National Curriculum requires that students commence learning to write by producing upper and lower case letters and progress through the years to write fluently and legibly with developing automaticity (see below for the relevant ACARA Content Descriptors). This is accomplished at a state and territory level by each of the education authorities prescribing the style of handwriting to be taught in their schools.

# The National Curriculum handwriting descriptors

Aussie School Fonts Plus fully covers the scope of the handwriting activities described in the National Curriculum and interpreted in the state guidelines.

- FOUNDATION: ACELY 1653- Produce some lower case and upper case letters using learned letter formations
- YEAR ONE: ACELY 1663- Write using unjoined lower case and upper case letters
- YEAR TWO: ACELY 1673- Write legibly with growing fluency using unjoined upper case and lower case letters
- YEAR THREE: ACELY 1684- Write using joined letters that are clearly formed and consistent in size
- YEAR FOUR: ACELY 1696- Write using clearly formed joined letters, and develop increased fluency and automaticity
- YEAR FIVE: ACELY 1706- Develop a handwriting style that is becoming legible, fluent and automatic

- YEAR SIX: ACELY 1716- Develop a handwriting style that is legible, fluent and automatic and varies according to audience and purpose
- YEAR SEVEN: ACELY 1727- Consolidate a personal handwriting style that is legible, fluent and automatic and supports writing for extended periods.

Anangu and Yolyu

To represent the full range of sounds in their languages, speakers of Pitjantjatjara in Central Australia and numerous Anangu and Yolnu languages in Arnhem Land use writing systems which include characters not usually found in the standard English alphabet.
